6. Background/Discussion/Evaluation/Conclusion**Background**

The Overstrand Municipality is, in terms of its Third Amendment Notice, dated 28 May 2003 a municipality with a mayoral executive system combined with a ward participatory system. Since 9 September 2021 the registration for

organisational sectors and geographical blocks for participation in the new generation of Ward Committees were advertised in local media and community. The elections were also promoted in local communities by way of:

- ✓ election posters placed on poles and community billboards,
- ✓ distribution of informative brochures to Councillors, Nominations and municipal helpdesks,
- ✓ SMS messages to Councillors, nominations and the broader public,
- ✓ social media via the municipal Face book page and website, and
- ✓ Announcement of meetings by way of loud hailing, were necessary.

The administration consulted with the newly elected Councillors at their induction workshop held on 11 November 2021 with regard to:

- ✓ related legal framework and Ward Committee Rules for Overstrand Municipality, and
- ✓ the programme and logistic arrangements for the establishment of the new generation of ward committees.

Ward Committee Elections took place from 15 until 18 November 2021 with the assistance of the Director: Community Services, respective Senior Managers and Manager, responsible for the administrations of Gansbaai, Hermanus and Kleinmond Area Managers, Manager: Labour Relations, Health and Safety, Senior Manager: Operational Services: Hermanus, Manager: Sport and Recreation, Senior Manager: Corporate Projects and other administrative staff. The Election timetable is attached as per Annexure A.

Discussion

Ward Committee Elections took place at 21 venues located within the demarcated 14 wards of the Municipality. A number of 5,956 registered voters (IEC's voters roll) resident in the 14 wards participated in the Ward committee Elections, as set out in table below:

- ✓ The election results are 133% improvement on the August 2016 Elections of Ward Committees,
- ✓ The average turnout per ward is 426 voters.
- ✓ The results in Ward 5 can be largely attributed to the rainy weather experienced during the day of the elections
- ✓ Female representation in Wards 1 and 9 is only one person, respectively and it will be requested that it be improved during the term of office.
- ✓ Youth development should also be embarked on to improve the representation of youth on Ward Committees.
- ✓ The turnout of voters for the elections in relation to the number of registered voters on the IEC's Voters roll (59,979 voters) was 10%

The administration would also like to express a word of appreciation regarding the election of the new generation of ward committees towards:

- ✓ the Executive Mayor, Councillors for their leadership, involvement, and support,
- ✓ the Overstrand Community and in particular the voters that largely contributed to the success of the elections, and
- ✓ the officials that took the responsibility for logistics and administrative duties before and during the election process.
