

dog that should create the impression that alternatives have been considered, whilst that is clearly not the case.

53. The lethargic approach to the identification and assessment of alternatives is underscored further by the decision not to consider at all the option of not implementing the activity, the so-called no-go option. Equally disappointing is the Municipality's decision not to give consideration at all to any alternative sites. We assume they would ascribe their failure to do so to the notion, referred to in paragraph 41 above, that they were searching for a site for an amphitheatre but for ways in which to 'upgrade' Piet-se-Bos. It would be difficult to sell such an argument, though, as only two options are proposed for the 'upgrading' of the site and the one component that appears to be indispensable is the amphitheatre.
54. Stripped from all pretenses what the public is confronted with is one alternative only with no proper explanation as to why the applicant saw fit not to give genuine consideration to any other alternatives. As we have pointed out in paragraph 16.2 above the applicant is obliged to prepare a basic assessment report in the format provided by the competent authority and Section E, paragraph 1(a) of the format prepared by the competent authority in this case enjoins an applicant who does not consider alternatives to give a '*... a detailed motivation ...*' of why it feels that '*... no reasonable or feasible alternative exist.*' We respectfully submit that only a very naive observer would be satisfied that any alternative other than alternative 1 was genuinely considered and assessed in the BAR and we submit therefore that the applicant is obliged to give a detailed motivation as to why it believes that no reasonable or feasible alternative exist. Failing such a motivation, we submit that the basic assessment process is fatally flawed on account of insufficient consideration of alternatives.
55. Assuming it were justifiable (we maintain it is not) to have the amphitheatre as the only alternative use, one would have expected the

basic assessment to deal with design or layout alternatives, technology alternatives and/or operational alternatives and in so doing at least attempted to address the concerns pertaining to noise. The applicant saw fit, though, not to embark upon this process and to leave the public with one alternative only, adding even further to the already flawed process.

56. Given the clean slate that Piet-se-Bos presents, it boggles the mind that the collective innovative spirit and expertise within the Municipality was unable to come up with a single genuine alternative. We submit that there rests a particularly heavy burden on the Municipality to exert time and energy on identifying many more alternatives as the subject property is a public open space which the Municipality holds in trust and must manage for the public at large. The upgrading and planning initiative has until now plainly not enjoyed the attention that it deserves and apart from the fact that the process is unlikely to pass legal scrutiny the proposal is tantamount to an insult to the Hermanus taxpayers whose rates and taxes will be utilised to fund whatever upgrade eventually takes place at Piet-se-Bos.

#### RECOMMENDATION

57. In the recommendation section of the BAR the statement is made that a validity period of three years for an environmental authorisation would be *"... fine but five would be better, given the municipal funding process that can only be commenced on an annual basis after environmental authorisation is obtained."*
58. The apparent premise for this recommendation, namely that the needs of the Municipality, as opposed to those of the environment, should determine the decision unfortunately permeates and taints further the report and the recommendations made therein.

**CONCLUSION**


59. For the reasons given above we are of the opinion that the BAR is incomplete and flawed and submit that an environmental authorisation cannot be issued lawfully on the basis thereof.
60. Our instructions are to suggest, as we hereby do, that a new basic assessment process be commenced as part of which a genuine effort will be made to identify, investigate and assess all environmental impacts and that will cater for proper public participation. Should our suggestion not be adhered to our instructions are finally to continue to challenge the validity of the process, not by means of correspondence to the competent authority and the Municipality, but ultimately in the form of appropriate court action if need be.
61. We trust that our clients' concerns will be afforded due attention and we look forward to learning what your response is to our suggestion in paragraph 60 above.



My experience with Kirstenbosch Concerts:

As a resident of Bishopscourt I live some 440 meters from the summer Sunday night concert at Kirstenbosch. The following are reasons why the sound emanating from the stage should be attenuated: their loudspeakers are pointing away from our property and my main house sits between the concert stage and my stoep! In addition there are many substantial trees and no line of sight between them and my property.

I can personally testify that visitors to our property during concert airings with average weather conditions are unable to converse normally when seated at a garden table on our stoep – classical music evenings excepted! Anyone who has personally witnessed this is quite dumbfounded at the din!

When Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens Directorate first approached us over 15 years ago for consent to their planned Sunday evening open air concerts, they told us:

- 17:30 – 19:00 duration - but in fact they start at 15:00 or earlier as artists and their support tune in and get accustomed to the stage set etc
- Small traffic impact – but in fact now they have to cater for 800 visitors and more, together with associated on-street parking problems
- 1 concert per week in main summer months – but in fact they last for 4.5 months during summer every weekend, plus four nights with Christmas Carols, interspersed with big artist performances during the week, who like to extend their performances to late at night
- Small amplification – but in fact they now have 2 very large huge loudspeaker towers
- Mainly for Classical music – but in fact these constitute only 1 now of the 24 concert evenings this year
- Starting from 24 Nov 2013, the line-up of artists is as follows: Prime Circle, Jack Parrow, Tailor/Mole/Toure, Mango Groove, Goldfish, Mtukudzi, The Parlotones, MacStandly, Johnny Clegg, Jummy Nevis, Fokopolisiekar, Civil Twilight, Freshlyground, Cape Philharmonic, Mi Casa, Hugh Masekela, CPT Music Festival, Desmond and the Tutus, Lira, Loops - ending 6 April

To add insult to injury we now have during winter, because the weather is not inviting for open air enjoyment, the associated restaurant offering WINTER Concerts – which are not as loud but still noise intrusive!

It is no wonder that property prices in that area of Bishopscourt are very depressed!

Your voluminous letter dated 21 October 2013 with regard to the abovementioned project refers.

As you may be aware a workshop on the Piet se Bos upgrade was held on 18 January 2014 in the municipal auditorium to which all registered I&APs were invited personally by letter. The workshop was also advertised in the Cape Argus and Burger as well as the Hermanus Times for two consecutive weeks inviting attendance. The workshop was held on a Saturday from 10h00-14h00 to give everybody the opportunity to attend. Despite this very wide and expensive advertising campaign, only approximately 90 people attended. It is a well known fact that with the vast majority of developments, the overwhelming sentiments are always by those opposed to the developments and not those in support of the developments who in most cases constitute what is referred to as "the silent majority".

To substantiate the abovementioned, just consider the quick mustering of support against a development which invariably results in the formation of the "Friends of ....Groups. A classic case in point is your own reference to the Kirstenbosch concerts which by your own admittance have become "extremely popular". The question now emerges, who now constitutes "the majority". We regard that issue as a very dangerous avenue to embark upon.

However, be it as it may, at the workshop the issues, concerns and impacts as well as the process followed were extensively discussed by those present. After the workshop the Overstrand Municipality opted to withdraw the construction of the proposed amphitheatre as the preferred option and also decided to reduce the scale of the proposed restaurant to be limited to a single storey wooden building.

A revised final BAR with a new preferred option was compiled of which you will receive notification of the availability in due course for your written comment. It will also contain a verbatim transcription of the workshop discussion as well as the revised plans for the proposed restaurant.

With regard to the majority of the other points raised in your letter, it is clear that they have become redundant as the amphitheatre is no longer the preferred option and we have therefore not responded to them. If you wish us to respond to them, please let us know and we will gladly do so.

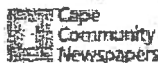

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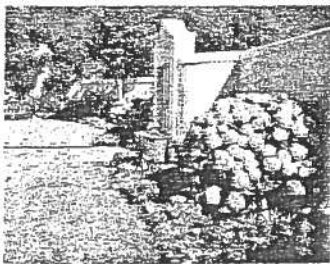

# 'English' garden flourishes

Roger Summers has no problems cultivating an English mass planted garden here in Hermanus and he thought readers may be interested to know this.

Having been a keen gardener in the UK, Summers (80) has enjoyed trying to make an English garden in our climate.

"It is possible. I grow lots of plants from seed and have some excellent roses. Other plants in the garden are chrysanthemums, impatiens, begonias, agapanthus, polygala, lots of lavender and indigenous geraniums, geranium, calendula, bougainvillea, cosmos, gladiolus, giant asters, penny royal, hollyhock, honeysuckle, alstromeria - to name a few. Perhaps other readers of the *Hermanus Times* would like to add their ideas for mak-

ing Hermanus even more beautiful."

The most colourful picture (above, right) shows, from front to back, winter pansies which are still flowering, petunias, lobelia, marigolds, delphiniums, larkspur, dahlias, asters, yesterday today and tomorrow and oleanders.

"At the moment there are sunflowers at the back. The idea is for plants to grow up through taller ones behind and even with the wind we get in Hermanus it works well".

Summers does have a bee in his bonnet though about some of the public green areas. "I must say that the condition of the cliff path in the town centre is appalling. People plant unsuitable plants in the wrong position and do not bother to water or maintain them and the cost goes on the rates."

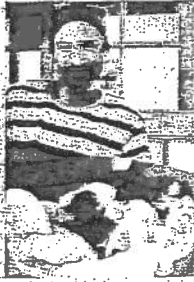

## Kittens dumped in refuse bag
