Hi Loretta,

I have seen the application by the Blue Roof Pub for the granting of an entertainment licence.

My personal objections are the following:-

1. The pub is situated in the middle of a quiet, peaceful residential area. The residents have moved here to escape the noise, hustle and bustle of a city. Now they are faced with having to endure loud music, raucous patrons and disturbances until the early hours of the morning;
2. There has already been an increase in crime in this area. Burglaries are occurring more often than in the past. An establishment offering liquor, music, dancing and everything that goes with it, will most certainly attract undesirable elements to the area and the crime rate can only increase;
3. Many of the patrons of the pub already show scant regard for driving under the influence of alcohol and when inebriated, they seem to believe that Fisherhaven roads have become a race track and they treat them accordingly. We have our wild horses, tortoises and other wild animals who roam freely and undisturbed in this area and a vehicle driven at excessive speed by an inebriated driver, places them in grave danger, particularly in view of the fact that many of the roads in Fisherhaven are gravel roads and are not very well lit. There are many dark spots in which a sober and careful driver needs to slow down and take cognisance of what is going on around his vehicle. This cautionary attitude does not exist in a drunk driver;
4. There is already an establishment in existence in Fisherhaven which offers the facilities being applied for by the Blue Roof. This establishment is run by residents of Fisherhaven who know the community and who temper their entertainment accordingly. It has been running for years and is well-frequented and respected by the residents;
5. With further regard to criminal elements being attracted to Fisherhaven via the Blue Roof, it is important to note that immediately next door to the Blue Roof, is the Haven Superette as well as Moo's Restaurant. An increase in criminal elements places these businesses in greater danger of break-ins and vandalism.

When the Blue Roof originally opened, the residents of Fisherhaven were quite happy about it, particularly in view of the Chinese restaurant that would operate below the pub. However, things have changed for the worse as time has progressed. There is already loud, raucous music and noise emanating from the pub until all hours of the night and residents in the immediate vicinity have to put up with the noise.

An entertainment licence with permissions extending to Saturdays and Sundays until 2 in the morning, it not what we want here in Fisherhaven. We have moved here for peace and quiet and we do not ascribe to the Blue Roof moving in here and trying to create a "club" atmosphere in our little village.

I wish to place on record my comments with regards the granting of an entertainment licence for the above establishment.

The owners own letter of motivation states that they do not have enough local support to operate the business and thus need to bring in custom from outside of Fisherhaven, to do so they feel the need to tread further on the communities toes by making more noise!

The establishment extended there business hours without input from neighbours and is now allowed to serve alcohol until 2am. Thank you for your letter of 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2014 forwarding copies of objections in respect of the above proposal for my comments. This is appreciated.

At the outset, I believe, you should be aware that out of four of the objectors, two are a married couple and the other two are in partnership and while I do not deny them their democratic right to object, their objections should be approached with caution as it is my view that in this instance their individual objections (not as couples) are "grudge" objections which have been lodged more to frustrate the approval of my application than the objections themselves bear true merit.

The one couple referred to are Tracey Whitelaw Coombe who is married to Cliff Coombe. They reside at 59 Riverside Drive which is the address Coombe uses in his objection. The letter of objection received from Tracey Whitelaw (omitting to use her legal married name) gives her address as 62 Broadway. This is a vacant erf adjacent to their residence recently purchased by them. This tactic they have employed is clearly designed to create the false impression that they are unrelated and to add more weight to their objections as separate individuals.

The other couple are Phillip Jonker and Heather Cowell and it is interesting to note that they have employed the same misleading tactic in giving their respective addresses as Erf 812 Riverside Drive and 19 Riverside Drive which are in fact one and the same property.

I feel you should also be made aware that Heather Cowell and Tracy Whitelaw Coombe are the administrators of a Facebook page that has been used largely by ill-wishers as a platform to propagate negative impressions against the Blue Roof and me as the owner for personal and even perhaps racial reasons. I am a Chinese born permanent resident of SA married to my SA husband. We have a son together. Face Book posts against me on this page include but are not limited to comments making reference to Chinese restaurants with a picture of skinned dogs being sold at a market. The decent people of Fisherhaven were outraged by this post and demanded from the administrators that this be deleted. Proof of this can be provided if required.

Heather Cowell also energetically and publicly campaigned unsuccessfully against the issuing of my liquor license.

- i. Letter No 8. P Kenderdine. I wish in particular to embellish on my response to this objection as it is typical of the false and malicious statements that have been posted by ill-wishers on the Face Book page mentioned above.

Ms Kenderdine's comments are totally unfounded and without any substance.

Point by point:

- The Blue Roof is zoned business and is situated in the centre of an area that was originally designated for business activities and not residential. For this reason it is buffered front and back from residential properties by public open space.
- The incidents of crime in the area in general cannot rationally or reasonably be related to a single establishment that has already been operating as a popular family pub & restaurant without incident since May 2014.
- The objector generalises about the consequences of drinking and driving which relate to any licensed establishment globally and her direct references to and her attack on the Blue Roof are unfounded and a figment of her imagination. As emphasized previously, there has not been one single incident or complaint that I am aware of in the history of this establishment.
- Once again the writer alludes to another establishment in Fisherhaven that is in existence and which offers the same facilities as the Blue Roof. There is no truth in this statement. The establishment she is referring to lost its liquor license and was ordered by Law Enforcement to stop all entertainment activities due to complaints by residents, was subsequently reported to the SAPS for selling liquor unlawfully, and whose owners are not residents of Fisherhaven as falsely alleged by the writer. This establishment is at present being used as a social club with darts and pool table activities and trades with no licenses whatsoever as are required by the authorities.
- Again the writer rambles on with no specific proof of any particular incident of disturbance as a reference. She refers to neighbouring businesses being adversely affected while to the contrary; there is in fact mutual support between these businesses. In her obvious confusion and distortion of the facts she refers also to a "club" atmosphere which is the exact opposite of what the Blue Roof offers as a family venue. There have been no late light disturbances and if anything, this "club" atmosphere she alludes to can only be related to past activities at the other establishment she makes reference to.

It should also be noted that contrary to the writer's confused allegations about "extended permissions" being granted, the application for an entertainment license has nothing to do with extending the Blue Roof's existing trading hours which are at present till 2:00am in keeping with the Municipal By-laws.

I trust that in view of this more factual information, you will disregard this objection in its entirety as totally void of any truth and just another unfounded and spiteful attack on a legitimate and popular business and its owner by an individual with personal grievances not shared by the community in general.

2. Letter No 4. Sheila Craul. This letter of objection should fall away as Ms Craul has sold her property. She now lives some distance away from the venue in question.

Since the opening of the Blue Roof Restaurant, there have been no traffic problems in The Crescent. Her comments with regard to residential vs. business are irrelevant due to the existing zoning in force.

3. Letter No 5. Adri Mostert. The Mostert's have only recently purchased their property (ex Sheila Craul). The Blue Roof was already operating as a Pub and Restaurant and one assumes they purchased the property with their eyes wide open and one assumes they were aware of the zoning of The Crescent before entering into the purchase of the property. The comments contained in the last two paragraphs are shameful and irrelevant to say the least and hold no merit as an objection with regard to the proposed consent use.
4. Letter No 13. Birgit Hoffmeyer. The property in question is at present a vacant overgrown plot with no signs of the commencement of any building operations and there are two "For Sale" boards fixed firmly on the property. This objection should be disregarded.
5. Letter No 11. Johan Smit. This property is situated some distance from the Blue Roof. The hours of operation referred to in the letter are within the Municipal Bye-Laws and are not subject to the proposed consent use. This objection is vague and appears to hold no merit.
6. Letter No 10. Dr MR Fisher. This letter of objection holds no merit. The Venue is NOT situated in a residential area and the usage is in accordance with the Town Planning requirements.
7. Letter No 7. PA Hoefnagel. This letter of objection should be rejected in its entirety. The antisocial behaviour referred to has never been experienced within the precincts of the Blue Roof and there is nothing to suggest or any evidence of criminal activities that are in any way related to the Blue Roof and/ or its business since opening in May 2014. It should be noted that these issues were never raised when the other venue (of whom Mr Hoefnagel is a regular patron) was operating nearby before they were ordered to cease business as there was no legal liquor license in force.
8. Letter No 9. Phillip Jonker. The objections in this letter are yet to be experienced by the objector and are pure conjectures on his part to say the least. Mr Jonker and his partner, Heather Cowell, are known to be outright opponents to the Blue Roof from the outset when they applied for a liquor license. All issues raised then and now against the Blue Roof however, were never brought against the other pub when it was operating without a liquor license or an entertainment license even though records from Law Enforcement will provide evidence of the number of complaints they were forced to deal with. Phillip and his partner

are also known to be promoters of this other establishment by way of their Group Facebook page. Evidence of this is available on request.

9. Letter No 12. Heather Cowell. There is no other licensed pub or restaurant providing service or entertainment within the area and there is a need to provide the communities of Benguela Cove, Arabella, Middlelei, Hawston and Vermont with this type of facility and good quality service. The Blue Roof has this to offer as is witnessed by the popularity of this venue since it opened in May 2014.

After we applied for extended hours, we were advised by the Liquor Licensing Authority that as per new regulations our trading hours were now governed by the Municipal By-Laws in force.

There is no evidence whatsoever to suggest that any "increase in disturbances at the public/ open/ unmanaged slipway with late night revellers extending their party to the banks of the Bot River with broken glass, wheel spinning, litter etc." can in any way be attributed to the Blue Roof and is a figment of imagination on the part of Ms Cowell.

10. Letter No 1. Tracey Whitelaw. This objector's residence is considerably closer to the unlicensed Catalina Pub but in any event it is certainly not our intention to introduce the type of live entertainment carried on at that venue previously and which invited complaints from residents.

We are very conscious of our local community and what they expect of us. If this objector is referring to the high level of noise that Greyton experienced arising from "Trans" parties, then her reasoning and comparison is absurd.

Her reference to increased traffic in a suburb which is already a target for antisocial behaviour is conjecture and her allegations pertaining to the ineptitude of Law Enforcement and SAPS are unfounded and should rather be taken up with their respective Director and Station Commander.

With regard to the objector's reference to her "Personal experience"- and trust of the Proprietor with regard to "Interest and safety of the community", I am unable to understand her allegations. If and when there have been "Valid views" of "The Villagers" we have endeavoured to enlighten and deal with their comments as far as possible.

11. Letter No 6. Vicki Hudson. The advertising on the roof of our building is compliant with the Municipal By-laws and has been approved by the OSM.

Initially I was not aware that a separate entertainment license was necessary and when this was established we immediately stopped "live music" in September 2014.

It is not our intention to create aggravation to nearby residents and volume control will be seriously monitored.

I am not oblivious to the concern of residents and the rural character of the area.

12. Letter No 3. A & J Masterson. We do not believe this objection warrants a detailed response. We have every sympathy with the problems they have with one of their sons but by their own admission they were aware of the zoning of The Crescent and their proximity now does not secure the right to regulate what businesses may operate in that area providing they are legally compliant.

It is a well known fact that Mr and Ms Masterson are patrons of the other and now unlicensed pub and were regulars at their Karaoke evenings. They are biased against our operation on the basis that there is "no room" for two venues which should be the prerogative of the Entrepreneurs concerned to assess and decide on. Their house is also for sale and was on the market long before the Blue Roof opened.

13. Letter No 2. Cliff Coombe. The objector makes reference to being accosted in the street by my husband which is an exaggeration and misrepresentation of the facts and therefore does not warrant further comment.

His other objections are repetitive of other objectors (as if they had consulted with each other) and have already been dealt with except sound proofing in the Blue Roof where in consideration of the nearest resident, two windows were in fact boarded up and sound-proofed voluntarily by myself from the outset, a fact that I am sure this objector is unaware of.

I hope that my response to the objections suffices and will further reinforce my application for an entertainment license.

- Not have late night "Club" activities


